Aishwarya Rai now on Russian magazine cover

Moscow, June 4 (PTI): After featuring on the cover of *Time* and China's *Beijing Review*, Bollywood diva Aishwarya Rai has now hit the cover of a popular Russian magazine, which dubs her "beauty number one".
